VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

The Race Committee is conducting the Australian Cross Country Ski Championships at Falls Creek on Saturday 8th and Sunday 9th August and is seeking the support of Club members to help conduct both events. The two events are:

Saturday 8th August

Australian Cross Country Sprint Championships.

This event starts at 9.30 am and should be finished by about 12.30 pm. Volunteers would need to report to the Race Hut in the Nordic Bowl by 9.00 am. The Race Committee needs volunteers to help at the start line, at the finish line, out on the course as Course Marshals and at the finish drink station to hand out drinks.

Sunday 9th August.

Australian Cross Country Distance Championship and the Falls Creek Junior Cup.

This event starts at 10.00 am and should be finished by about 1.30 pm. Volunteers would need to report to the Race Hut in the Nordic Bowl by 9.30 am. Again, the Race Committee needs volunteers to help at the start line, at the finish line, out on the course as Course Marshals and at the finish drink station to hand out drinks and collect race bibs.

The Race Committee has appointed "Chiefs" for all the major positions (Starter, Timing and Course Marshal Coordinator etc) and they need a small army of support staff on both days. If you have volunteered to help run races in the past then you are very welcome. If you have never volunteered to help run races you are also very welcome. The Race Committee has some very experienced race officials who are very willing to give first time volunteers some on the job training and support.

If you are prepared to help out on one or both days then please contact Jim Gargan, who is the Volunteer Coordinator and will be responsible for the allocation of tasks for both days.

“HOPPET HELPERS”

Volunteer Workforce for the 2009 Kangaroo Hoppet

Dear Club Member

The Kangaroo Hoppet Race Committee is a sub-committee of the Birkebeiner Nordic Ski Club and is given the responsibility of organising and conducting the Kangaroo Hoppet (KH), the Australian Birkebeiner (AB) and the Joey Hoppet (JH) on the last Saturday in August each year. The 2009 Race Committee is seeking volunteers from Club members, and from members of the general community, to help in this major task.

Below is a detailed description of some specific volunteer positions. If you can help in any way, shape or form please get in contact with Jim Gargan by phone (57541785) or by email on gargan@internode.on.net

“Hoppet Helpers” required on Thursday 20th August.

Working Bee - Helpers wanted to pack the race bags for the Hoppet

Thursday August 20, 9.30 – noon at the Auditorium next to the Mt Beauty Visitor Information Centre. Morning tea provided.

“Hoppet Helpers” required on Friday 28th August.

Setting up the start/finish area in the Falls Creek Nordic Bowl.

This task will be co-ordinated by Phil Evans (Chief of Stadium) and Peter Panozzo (Assistant Chief of Stadium) and will start at 9.30 am at the Race Hut in the Falls Creek Nordic Bowl and should finish at about 3.00 pm. Volunteers are needed to help put up fences, tents, bunting, flags and signs in and around the Nordic Bowl and at the Drink Stations in the National Park.

All volunteers need to make their own way from Mt Beauty to Falls Creek Windy Corner Car Park and then either walk or ski the 1 km up to the Nordic Bowl. All volunteers need to bring their own lunch and come dressed for the weather conditions on the day.

“Hoppet Helpers” required on Saturday 29th August

1. Finish setting up the start/finish area in the Falls Creek Nordic Bowl.

This task will also be co-ordinated by Phil Evans and Peter Panozzo and will start at 7.30 am at the Race Hut in the Nordic Bowl and will finish by 9.00 am. About 10 volunteers are needed to help finish off setting up the start/finish area.

2. Finish Line Marshals.

This task will involve marshalling competitors when they finish their event, remove the ankle band timing device and giving out the Hoppet Badges. Six volunteers are needed for the first shift from 9.30 am to 12.30 pm and four volunteers for the second shift from 12.30 to about 4.00 pm.

BNSC members who have skied in the Joey Hoppet or the Australian Birkebeiner are encouraged to volunteer for the second shift starting at 12.30 pm

3. World Loppet Passport Stamping

This task will involve stamping Worldloppet passports at the finish from about 1 - 3.30 p.m. or part thereof.

4. Course Marshals

The three course marshals that are required will be co-ordinated by Brian Keeble. Don't be put off by the apparent complex nature of these tasks. Detailed explanations will be given on the morning of the race.

Sun Valley Marshal. One marshal is required. This marshal needs to pick up a radio from the SES

Building at Windy Corner sometime shortly after 8.00 am and then ski out to the “turn around” point at the far end of Sun Valley and be in position by 9.30 am. The marshal has three main tasks. The first task is to make sure all competitors turn back towards the Dam Wall on their first lap. The second task is to make sure that all Kangaroo Hoppet competitors go straight ahead and around the lake on their second lap. The third task is to close the course at the second cut off time of 1.00 pm (which is 3.5 hours after the start of the Kangaroo Hoppet). At 1.30 pm the marshal can abandon the position and the final task is to make sure the radio is returned to the SES Building.

Dam Wall Marshal – Falls Creek Side of the Dam Wall. Two marshals are required. These two marshals need to pick up a radio from the SES Building at Windy Corner sometime shortly after 8.00 am and then ski (or walk) out to the Falls Creek side of the Dam Wall and be in position by 9.30 am. These marshals have the responsibility of directing the Kangaroo Hoppet and Australian Birkebeiner competitors over the Dam Wall and directing the Joey Hoppet competitors back to the finish line in the Nordic Bowl. More specific details of these duties will be given to these two marshals on the day. At about 12.00 noon the marshals can abandon their position and their final task is to return their radio to the SES Building.

Dam Wall Marshal – Park Side of the Dam Wall. One marshal is required. This marshal needs to pick up a radio from the SES Building at Windy Corner sometime shortly after 8.00 am and then ski (or walk) out to the Park side of the Dam Wall and be in position by 9.30 am. This marshal has the responsibility of (1) directing the Kangaroo Hoppet and Australian Birkebeiner competitors coming over the dam wall onto the road towards Watchbed Creek, (2) directing Kangaroo Hoppet and Australian Birkebeiner competitors coming down off Heathy Spur towards the Nordic Bowl and (3) directing Kangaroo Hoppet competitors coming back from Watchbed Creek (on their second lap) towards the Nordic Bowl. More specific details of these duties will be given to these two marshals on the day. At about 12.00 noon the marshals can abandon their position and their final task is to return their radio to the SES Building.

5. Final Clean Up.

This task will be co-ordinated by Phil Evans and Peter Panozzo. The first part of the clean up will start at 2.00 pm in the start area and the task is to pack away all the fencing, bunting and signs in that area. The second part of the clean up will start at about 3.00 pm in the finish area and the task is to start packing away the fencing, bunting and signs in the finish area. Both tasks need about 10 volunteers.

6. Results Display Preparation

Helen needs some helpers late Saturday after the race to prepare the result boards to hang at the stadium. I need at least six people from 6 - 7 pm at the Hoppet Shop (Auditorium). The more the merrier - "Many hands make light work".

Over the past few years BNSC members who have competed in one of the events have volunteered for these tasks. I would again encourage all Club members, who have skied in their event, to consider volunteering. The more volunteers the quicker the task and the sooner we can all pack up and head down the mountain for the presentations and celebrations in Mt Beauty.
